



Tuberculosis Awareness Guide for Trainers

APHF has partnered with the TB Elimination Alliance to help address the prevalence of tuberculosis, especially within Asian communities. APHF's strategy to lower the transmission of TB is to provide information and encourage screening. Interested community members have the option of watching Dr. Fang's TB conference video to receive their education. Volunteers can likewise receive their training this way to become a TB Education Trainer at outreaches. You can also share this document with family members and friends who are interested in learning more about TB. We hope to educate as many people as possible!

Please follow these steps to complete the education process. Non-volunteers are eligible for a \$25 gift card raffle upon completion of these steps:

1. The pre-knowledge assessment gauges what you know about TB thus far. Prior knowledge regarding TB is not required.
2. Upon completion of the pre-knowledge assessment, you are required to watch a TB conference recording hosted by Dr. Michelle Fang, an infectious disease pharmacist. Her discussion of TB aims to provide adequate knowledge about TB to complete the post test.
3. After watching the video, you are required to complete the post-education assessment test. Passing this test will certify volunteers to begin educating others about TB.
