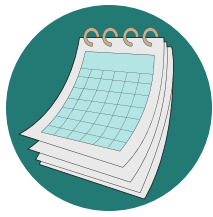


WHAT IS VIRAL HEPATITIS B?

80,000 Americans become infected every year

100X

more infectious than HIV or AIDS



Primary cause of liver cancer, which is the 2nd leading cause of cancer deaths in the world



Immigrants from Asia, the Pacific Islands, and Africa are at very high risk

Health care workers



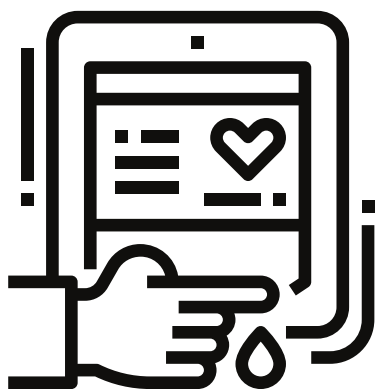
Illicit drug users

Long Term Effects

Left untreated hepatitis B infection can lead to

- Liver failure
- Liver transplant
- Liver cancer
- Death

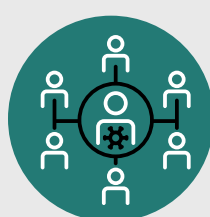
PREVENTION OF HEPATITIS B



Hepatitis B is preventable, not curable



There is a 2 dose vaccine available to prevent infection



A silent disease. Infected people can be asymptomatic.



Testing is vital for prevention of the spread of hepatitis B
